

BEAUTIFUL DOLL

Man and lady use same foot all thru dance
Couples facing, Man faces LOD. Banjo position - Right hips adjacent
hands joined, arms extended.

- I. Do one California Schottische step changing to Left side; then back.
 (Point Left to front, point Left to side, then step behind, ^{with Left} step on Right,
 step on Left and hold. (Weight on L foot) Both move to Right so Left
 hips are adjacent.)
 (Point Right to front, point Right to side, step behind with Right,
 step on Left, step on Right and hold; moving to Left so Right hips are
 adjacent.)
- II. Man walks fwd. LOD; Lady backs up and turns step.
 (Man:- Walk left, walk right, step-close-step; walk right, walk left,
 step-close-step.
 Lady:-Back left, back right, step-close-step & turn Right face; fwd.
 right, fwd. left, step-close-step. (On turn keep inside hands
 joined.)
- III. Facing LOD, Open Position, Inside hands joined; One California Schottische
 Step.
 (Both facing LOD - same footwork for both - Point fwd left, side left,
 step behind, step, close, point fwd right, side right, step behind,
 step, close.)
- IV. LOD - Heel, Toe and Two-Step L R L
 Left heel fwd, left toe back, step-close-step
R L R
 Right heel fwd, right toe back, step-close-step
- V. Four Two-steps - Inside Hands Joined
 Man leads lady around fwd. turning Left and Lady goes to gent behind,
 while man makes half turn to face LOD and new lady.

-- Repeat entire dance from beginning --

Ending: One California Schottische step and bow.
