

## DO-SA-DO MIXER

ISSUED JAN 1953

Originated by Leonne Cottle of Huntington, West Va. as appeared in  
Sets In Order, November 1952.

Position: Facing with both hands joined. Gent's back to center.

MUSIC : Down South - Victor 20-4568

START : Gent's L and Lady's R. Directions for gent.

FIGURE :

1-2 STEP CLOSE STEP CLOSE SLIDE 2-3-HOLD

Step left to side and close R to L; Repeat; three slides to  
the left and hold.

3-4 STEP CLOSE STEP CLOSE SLIDE 2-3- HOLD.

Repeat measure 1-2 moving to the right.

5-6 STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH

Step L to side and touch R toe behind L heel, repeat to  
the right and then to the left and right again.

7-8 DO-SA-DO AND ON TO THE NEXT

Drop hands and do a right shoulder do-sa-do in eight steps  
Take the hands of the next person to the right. NOTE: Ray  
Shaw has his dancers do the do-sa-do in six steps and use  
the other two steps to go to the next person on their left.
