Position: Facing with both hands joined. Gent's back to center. MUSIC Down South - Victor 20-4568 : Gent's L and Lady's R. Directions for gent.

START

- STEP CLOSE STEP CLOSE SLIDE 2-3-HOLD 1-2 Step left to side and close R to L: Repeat; three slides to the left and hold.
- STEP CLOSE STEP CLOSE SLIDE 2-3- HOLD. 3**-**4 Repeat measure 1-2 moving to the right.
- 5-6 STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH STEP TOUCH Step L to side and touch R toe behind L heel, repeat to the right and then to the left and right again.
- DO-SA-DO AND ON TO THE NEXT 7-8 Drop hands and do a right shoulder do-sa-do in eight steps Take the hands of the next person to the right. NOTE: Ray Shaw has his dancers do the do-sa-do in six steps and use the other two steps to go to the next person on their left.
