MIXMASTER WALTZ

Any good waltz not faster than 40 meas per minute and with a strong accent. RECORD:

"Arizona Waltz" - Old Timer 1950; "Anniversary Waltz" - Columbia 50064; "Just a Girl that Men Forget" - Decca 71548; "Hi Lilli" - Shew X 60.

Partners facing, Mis back to COH, M's R and W's L hands joined. POSITION:

FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout.

MEASURES:

- 1- 4 BAL APART, TOUCH, -; BAL TOGETHER, TOUCH, -; BAL FWD, TOUCH, -; BAL BWD, TOUCH, -; Keeping hand holds, starting M's L take short step bwd away from partner, bring free foot (M's R) to instep of L, hold this position and bow slightly to partner; Step twd partner on R, touch L to R as pivot 1 to face LOD; Step fwd on L, touch R to L and hold; Step bwd in RLOD on R, touch L to R and hold.
- 5-8 WALTZ AWAY,2,3; TOGETHER,2.3; AWAY,2,3; CHANGE SIDES,2,3; Step diag fwd away from partner on L, then R, and step L beside R as turn twd partner; Step R. L. then R beside L still moving fwd diag to return to side of partner; Repeat action of Meas 5 away from partner; Change sides with partner in 3 steps RLR as W turns L-face under her own L and M's R arm (Calif. Whirl) to end with M now on outside and W on inside of circle facing each other -not too far apart and holding M's H and W's L hands.
- 9-12 BAL APART, TOUCH, -; BAL TOGETHER, TOUCH, -; BAL FWD, TOUCH, -; BAL BWD, TOUCH, -; Repeat Meas 1-4 moving in RLOD.
- 13-16 WALTZ AWAY, 2, 5; TOGETHER, 2, 5; AWAY, 2, 5; CHANGE PARTNERS, 2, 3; Repeat Meas 5-7. On Meas 16 the dance becomes a "mixor" as the M drops partner's hand and moves back to inside of circle with a \frac{1}{2} L-face turn in 3 steps RLR as he faces new partner, his former corner or the W behind him and takes her I hand in his R. At the same time the W changes back to outside of circle with a 3/4 L-face turn in 3 steps LRL to face her new partner, the M formerly in front of her in the dancing circle. Note -- it is important to drop handholds on the first count of Meas 16 to turn immediately to face new partner.
- ENDING: As music stops, partners change to a new partner, bowing and the curtay with this new one.
