WALKIN' MARIE

Originated by Brocky and Clem Brockelman of Houston, Texas as appeared in Foot and Fiddle, November 1952.

POSITION: Open dance with inside arms linked sweetheart style.

MUSIC : WALKIN' MARIE - Longhorn 101

START : Gent's L and Lady's R. Directions for gent.

FIGURE :

- 1-4 WALK 2-3-4  
Walk four stroll steps in LOD, end facing holding hands.
- 5-6 STEP SWING STEP  
Step L, swing R across, step R in place facing RLOD.
- 7-10 WALK 2-3-4  
Walk four steps in RLOD (L-R-L-R)
- 11-12 Swing Left across as face partner, step L swing R and step L.
- 13-16 WALTZ, WALTZ, WALTZ, LADY TWIRL  
Four waltz measures in closed dance position, gent marking time on last measure while lady does R face twirl.
- 17-20 STEP STEP SWING: STEP STEP SWING:  
Gent facing LOD, arms extended from shoulders to sides and palms together step L and R in LOB and swing L repeat with R-L and swing R.
- 21-24 WALTZ, WALTZ, WALTZ, WALTZ.  
Four closed dance waltz steps to twirl on last waltz to starting position.

Repeat four times for the recording. Ending eight sweetheart walking steps a twirl and bow.
