 3-4..Stp apt on L,-,point R twd ptr,-; Stp tog R picking W up to CP fcg
 LOD,-,tch L,-;

1-4 (CP-LOD)FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; (PRG SCISS)SD,CLO,CROSS,-; SD,CLO,
CROSS,-;
 1-2..In CP fcg LOD do 2 fwd two-steps down LOD;;
 3-4..Sd L, clo R, XLIF (W-XIB),-; Sd R, clo L, XRIF (W-XIB),-;
 5-8 (BJO HITCH)FWD,CLO,BK,-; (HITCH SCISS)BK,CLO,FWD(SCP),-; VINE,2,3,4;
FWD,-,PICK UP,-;
 5-6..In bjo fcg LOD fwd L, clo R, bk L,-; BK R, clo L, fwd R,-(W sciss
 thru) end SCP fcg LOD;
 6-8..Blend to CP fcg wall sd L, both XIB, sd L, both XIF; Fwd L,-,
 fwd R,-(pick W up to CP fcg LOD);

9-16 REPEAT MEAS 1-8 PART A END IN BFLY FCG WALL

1-4 (BFLY)FACE TO FACE; BK TO BK; CHANGE SDS,2,3,-; AROUND TO BFLY,2,3,-;
 1-2..In bfly fcg wall sd L, clo R, sd L trng LF $\frac{1}{2}$ (W RF) to a bk to bk
 pos M's R & W's L hand joined,-; Sd R, clo L, sd R trng RF to fc
 LOD (W LF),-;
 3-4..Join M's L & W's R hand changing sds two-step L,R,L,- W crossing
 under joined hands; Retaining joined hands two-step R,L,R,- around
 to bfly M fcg COH;
 5-8 TWIRL/VINE TWD RLOD,2,3,-; REV TWIRL/VINE,2,3,-; (BFLY LIMP)SD,BEHIND,SD,
BEHIND; (OP-RLOD)WALK,-,2,-;
 5-6..M now fcg COH Vine twd RLOD sd L, XIB, sd L,(W twirl RF),-; Reverse
 twirl/vine twd LOD sd R, XIB, sd R,- (W twirl LF);
 7-8..In bfly M fcg COH sd L, behind R, sd L, behind R; Blend to OP fcg
 RLOD fwd L,-, fwd R,-;

9-16 REPEAT MEAS 1-8 PART B TWD RLOD PICK UP W ON LAST FWD STP TO CP FCG LOD

ENDING

1-3 Blend to bfly (LIMP)SD,BEHIND,SD,BEHIND; WALK,-,2,-; APT/POINT,-,-,-;
